- Its application should benefits Companies and Workers, simultaneously, and take in consideration the aspects related to the environmental and safety conditions of each job.



# 1.1.GOOD HYGIENE PRACTICES AT WORK IN TOURISM SECTOR

## Hygiene rules

The way we present to the others, specially in tourism sector, is very important to make a good first impression.

That could determinate if client stays in the restaurant, hotel, etc. and if they will come back.

In the other hand, a good self-presentation could help you to maintain your job.

#### Some examples:

- Daily bath;

# Safety rules

- Occupational safety aims to combat occupational accidents from a non-medical point of view.
- In one hand occupational safety pretends to eliminate unsafe conditions and environments, and in the other hand educate workers to use preventative measures.

# Safety rules

 In workplaces is possible to identify a set of factors related to neglect or inattention by the non use of elementary rules that enhance the possibility of accidents or problems.

# Safety rules

- Main safety rules:
  - Correct use of machines and utensils;
  - Correct use of self-protection equipment;
  - Fulfillment of orders and instructions;
  - Have some knowledge about:
    - First aid;
    - Toxic products;
    - Fire fighting;
    - Product labeling according to the Community legislation;
    - Ecologic knowledge...

# **Self-protection**

- Individual protection measures should be a priority.
- All personal use devices that intended to protect the physical integrity and health of the worker shall be considered personal protective equipment.
- Self-protection equipment do not prevent accidents. It only decrease or prevent injuries that can result from accidents.

#### **Health vs Disease**


Occupational disease is a disease caused by working conditions that result in the inability to work or even death of the worker.


To avoid the occupacional disease is very important to:

Always stay in NEUTRAL posture.

Neutral posture can mean a more productive and more comfortable day.

#### Bad postures could cause:

- Back and neck pain;
- Arms or forearm and hands pain;
- Tiredness;
- Discomfort.

# Harmful agents

Physical agents (heat, cold, pressure, sound, vibrations...).

Chemical agents (detergents, perfumes, clothing).

Biological agents (pathogenic agents).


Health and safety in accesible and inclusive tourism sector



- be aware witch are the harmful agents and how you keep you healthy...




