- **Confidenciality** in customer service. Communication.








2.3 CLEANING OF COMMON AREAS IN A TOURIST ACOMMODATION







2.5 SPECFIC RISKS PREVENTION

What are the risks of a room and cleaning assistant in your workplace?

The activity of room and cleaning assistant carries certain risks that the professionals must always take into account when working.

- 1. The disorder

- 3. The use of machines
- 4. The electricity
- 5. Manual transport of heavy items
- 6. Toxic hazard

- 11. Mental overload






Mess

It can cause falls and with them injuries such as sprains, cervical injuries, cuts, etc.

It is very important that everything is ordered, besides giving a good image of the stay, avoids risk of accidents .





POOR STORAGE OF PRODUCTS AND TOOLS.

It is necessary to have a storage for the products and tools that we are going to use, it is also obligatory, to maintain some rules regarding the storage of such belongings.





THE USE OF MACHINES

Currently there is a great variety of machinery that makes us much work, you have to bear in mind that, to use a cleaning machine, we must be authorized to do so and know perfectly how it is handled.






ELECTRICITY

It is very important to pay special attention when we are working near a source of electricity, for example plugs or cables.

Electricity cannot be seen, heard, or smelled and is present in all the activities that we are going to perform.





MANUAL TRANSPORT OF HEAVY LOADS

Improper handling of heavy loads can cause injury to the back or neck.

We must use the cleaning trolley to carry loads.

In the case of not having a trolley, we must follow the rules of prevention of risks, avoiding to carry a lot of weight.

TOXIC HAZARD

Products used in the room and cleaning assistant activity can cause accidents and serious damage if they are used incorrectly.

It is necessary to read the label of each product and to comply with the rules of risk prevention.





FIRE HAZARD

Fires are a danger in any place where we are going to develop the activity.

There are **evacuation plans** that allow us to know what to do incase of fire.

We must know what rules we will follo w in case of fire risk.





NOISE

Noise is an obvious danger to the state of health.

Noise may cause headaches, hearing loss, etc. in the long term.






EXTREME HEAT

Heat is a risk to which the professional should habituate. Heat can lead from exhaustion to the dreaded heat strokes.

It is necessary to hydrate, drinking water periodically. Also, we should try to maintain good ventilation in the workplace and finally, organize the work incorporating short periods of rest.






BAD LIGHTING

Working with good visibility will always avoid unnecessary risks.

Failing to do so may result in falls, shocks and, of course, no proper work.






MENTAL WORDLOAD

USAGE RULES:


- o It's the personal use.

2.7 LABELLING CLEANING PRODUCTS


Many commonly used cleaning products contain chemicals that may be hazardous to human health or to the environment.





The chemical products, substance or preparation, classified as hazardous,

must include in tis packaging a well-visible label.






- This label is the first basic information
- for the user about the dangers inherents in the product
- and the precautions that
- it should take in its Manipulation.

This label, written in the official language of the state, must be understable to all people.

Labelling cleaning products Room and cleaning assistant

ALL PRODUCTS MUST CONTAINAL LEAST:





- 2. The full address and phone number of the manufacturer.
- 3. The composition (the ingredients of the products).
- 4. Indications of danger.
- 5. What to do in case of accident.
- The CE symbol, which indicates that its sale is legal and has passed the security controls in order to use it.










Basic cleaning utensils

Broom

- Serve for sweeping.
- There are differents types of brooms according to each type of soil.

Picker

 It is used to collect the waste that has been swept from the ground.

 It is used in wet way to drag the remaining dust after sweeping







Basic cleaning utensils

Cube

- Mop bucket is filled with water and detergent product
- It is used to wet the mop and rinse it
- Has a wringer to drain the mop
- According to each type of floor, different passes are made inthe form of «s»,
- Moving from inside to outside.

Dust mop

Serves to brighten the floor.

Vacuum cleaner

- Serves to suck dust from the ground.
- Some of them suck water.







Basic cleaning utensils

Staircase

It serves to reach places of difficult access like windows or curtains, and to be able to clean more easily.

Scourer

It is a piece of crushed steel that serves to scrub.

Suede

- It is a soft tissue cloth
- Serves to clean the dust

Glove

- Serves to cover the hand
- It can be made of rubber, plastic or other material.
- It is used to protect the skin







Basic cleaning products

Cleaners

 For cleaning surfaces such as floors, bathrooms, crystals, tiles, etc.



Brighteners

serve to give more shine to the Surfaces. Protects floors.

Solvents

- are used to clean traces of grease, tar.
- They are dangerous.

Soaps

Removes the dirt layer from a surface, furniture, etc.



Basic cleaning products

Detergents

They serve to dissolve dirt and stains.

Captured-dust

 They are used to capture dust, they tend to be in spray format.

Descaling

Remove the rest of the salts from a Surface.

Degreasers

Clean salt surfaces.

Ammonia

 It is used to remove stains from crystals, tiles, marble, carpets, etc.



Basic cleaning products

Disinfectants

 They attack bacteria, eliminating furniture and surface bacteria.

Bleach

Brighteners

 They are formed by wax and resins, they create a layer and give shine.

Paint strippers

 They eliminate glass residues and prepare a floor to be later polished

Crystallizers

They serve to polish marble floors and terrace.

Glass cleaner

 They serve to clean crystals and remove fat from crystals, TV, light bulbs.



Basic cleaning products

Metal cleaner

 They are used to clean, protect and Polish metals.

Specific products:

- Wood cleaners
- Stainless stell cleaners.
- Air fresheners
- Drain cleaners.
- Anti-lime.

3.3 FURNITURE FROM CLEANING COMMON AREAS

Furniture from cleaning common areas Room and cleaning assistant

Types of floor

There are 3 main types of floors:


- Porous hard floor
- Smooth hard floors
- Soft floor

Porous hard floor:

- They are very common (marble, terrazzo,cement, Concrete)
- ✓ They are hard and cold floor
- \checkmark It takes a long time to wear
- ✓ It's hard to clean

Smooth Hard floor:

- ✓ They are more sensitive
- ✓ Barely wear
- \checkmark They are the floors of granite, tile, stoneware.



Types of floors

Soft floors:

- ✓ They are plastic floors like PVC
- ✓ Rubber Flooring
- ✓ Wooden floors
- ✓ They are damaged by excess moisture





Furniture from cleaning common areas Room and cleaning assistant

Furniture and accesories

The **furniture** is the sets of furniture and objects that formpart of a space, in this case, of a tourist accommodation.

Examples are: chairs, tables, sofas, shelves, crystals, ceilings, walls, floors, etc.

 The furniture of a tourist accommodation can be of: wood, leather, upholstery, metal, Plastic and Glass.



 The doors and windows can be of: aluminium, lacquered aluminium, plastic, etc

Furniture from cleaning common areas Room and cleaning assistant

Furniture and accesories

- Steel surfaces
- Lamps and Light points (allogenic)
- Outdoor streetlights (terrace)
- Floors and pavements that can be: ceramic, PVC plastics, terrazzo, marble, tiles, granite and Stone agglomerat
- Parquet Flooring.
- Carpets
- Crystals that can be: beveled, smooth opaque, translucent, mirrors, etc.









3.4 CLEANING MACHINES


Cleaning machines Room and cleaning assistant

In the case of a tourist accommodation, the machines used for cleaning different areas are:

 scrubbers: for cleaning corridors, floors of halls, reception, etc.



- **Polisher**: it serves to wax the soils and make them brighter.
- Vacuum cleaner: for the removal of dirt and dust on floor, rugs and Carpets.
- Steam-cleaning machine: used for cleaning curtains and furniture.




6.3 ORGANIZATION OF THE STORAGE ROOM

Organization of the storage room Room and cleaning assistant

The storage zones must have the following characteristics:


- Communicate with the outside and be accessible to freight vehicles.
- They must be organized so that cleaning products do not mix with Others.
- The place has to have the appropriate environmental conditions for the preservation of the chemical products.
- The store must be in good condition for cleaning and hygiene





Organization of the storage room Room and cleaning assistant

- The dimensions of the storage area must be suitable for the machinery and if they can, have plugs to recharge the same.
- The shelves should be large and with distance between them to keep the products well ordered.
- The products in the store have to be identified with labels.





Organization of the storage room Room and cleaning assistant

The features of a storage room are the following:

- On the shelves there will be labels that indicate the place of storage of each utensil and of each product.
- The utensils are placed in the upper shelves, in the intermediate the unopened products and in the lower the cleaning products open.

Organization of the storage room Room and cleaning assistant Storage room

6.4 INVENTORY

An **inventory** is a count of each type and kind of material that you have in a storage room area of a tourist accommodation.

The inventory collects the data from:

- Other (pillows, hangers, Etc)



7.3 HOTEL ROOM CLEANING

Hotel room cleaning

Room and cleaning assistant

□ Place a cleaning notice on the Door.

□ All windows will open to ventilate

Place guests ' clothes on.

The first thing to do is to place it as it is in a place that allows us to work, at the end of the cleaning we will put back to the place where it was.

□ Collect any waste or debris from customers who are insight.

Place a new garbage bag in the spaces that need it.





- □ Clean the bedside tables, if it is of any material such as wood or iron, use special cleaning products.
- □ Also check that there are no objects in the drawers.
- □ Ventilate the wardrobe and if necessary aspire the inside.
- Clean glass and windows, remember to use a special cloth and dry at the end to avoid a bad finish.
 - Sucks and scrubs the surface.



Hotel room cleaning Room and cleaning assistant

□ Vacuum the floor, If you have carpet,

use specific products to clean carpets

but be aware of the cleanliness of each type of floor.

Scrub the Floor.

Remember to use specific products for the soil material and change the water at least every two rooms, to prevent dirty water from generating bad smells. Scrub from the inside- Outside.



Before finishing the scrubbing, review the doors to avoid traces of fingerprints or to check that they are working properly.


7.4 BATHROOM CLEANING

Bathroom cleaning Room and cleaning assistant

Bathroom cleaning.

- 1. First, we will clean the tiles using a wet scouring pad, so that the surface is not scratched.
- 2. After this we will apply a disinfectant product to get a Deep hygiene, especially in the toilet, and thus eliminate the germs.
- 3. It will clean the bath, screen and sink, with products special, advisable the anti-limescale.
- 4. We'll clean mirrors and taps
- 5. Finally, we must place the towels and place the garbage bags, toilet paper, hand soap on it dispenser, etc.







Become responsible for your actions



Data protection Act.

All employees of the tourist establishment must comply with the law. In the case of Spain:

Organic Law 15/1999 for the protection of Personal data(LOPD).

This law aims to "guarantee and protect the rights and freedoms of natural persons, especially their honor and privacy", being applicable to any company with files in Spain, regardless of whether it is national or foreign.

Therefore, the protection of information must have a high level of security so that it is protected as the law establishes.

may have serious consequences for

both the company and the employee.

BLUE CONTAINER

We'll deposit all kinds of paper, cardboard, magazine, etc. that we want to throw.

No Dirty paper is deposited, such as used paper tissues, kitchen paper or toilet paper.





WHAT KIND OF WASTE SHOULD BE DEPOSITED IN EACH CONTAINER? In Spain...

GREEN IGLOO

We'll deposit jars or bottles of glass that we want to throw away.

The glass is not deposited,

for example

remains of utensils (glasses, dishes...)

broken or broken glass like

mirrors or windows.





WHAT KIND OF WASTE SHOULD BE DEPOSITED IN EACH CONTAINER?

In Spain...

YELLOW CONTAINER

We will deposit containers of use and pull, for example bottles, cans, coffee cups, bags, yoghurts, tetra-brik, etc.

Do not deposit the rest of the plastic that is not to use and throw, for example a plastic toy, a table, a chair, etc.

DARK GREEN CONTAINER

We will deposit the waste of organic matter and those residues that cannot be recycled, toilet paper, etcetera.

SMALL STEPS TO MAKE A BIG IMPACT

Use water saving (low flow) shower heads, toilets, and laundry machines. Use linenless tables. Implement a water savings' program for guests to participate in, including linen/towel reuse.

REDUCE WASTE

Recycle plastic, paper, and aluminum. Use/sell recycled goods. Don't use paper/plastic cups, straws, or stir sticks. Use water filling stations for water bottles. Have a compost program.



SAVE ENERGY

Switch to energy efficient lighting, and invest in energy saving appliances and electronics. Use solar and wind power. Use motion censors and auto shut off air. when doors left open.

BE FOOD SAVVY

Buy locally grown, organic, and sustainable food. Have your own garden and greenhouse. Compost and donate leftovers to food banks. Use ORCA machines to manage food waste.





BUILD SMART

Use energy star windows, cooling roofs, and sustainable materials. Optimize heat/air systems, reduce water needs with water pervious rocks and native landscaping, and use safe materials.

START SMALL
